## September 20, 2011 Meeting

- Rose has sent out the celiac
   pamphlets to the gastroenterologists in the area. If you
   know of a doctor that did not
   get one, let her know so that
   she can get some information
   out to them.
- We talked about the Gluten
   Free Conference that a few of us attended over the summer.
   Things we learned:
  - ◆ The GF diet doesn't work in 34% of people.
  - ◆ The international code for a GF meal: GFM L
  - ♦ There are 60 proteins in a wheat grain that cause certain reactions. Celiac being one, Schizophrenia being another. Right now, the test only tests 1 of them but they are working on a test that will test for 10.
  - Celiac disease falls under the larger umbrella of Gluten Sensitivity.

- New dues price is \$10 for the fiscal year. You are also encouraged to join the national GIG group.
- We would like to have an educational component at each meeting. If you have something that you would like to research and present to the group, just let Rose know.






